Academic Highlights 2015

IB, A Level, AS, BTEC, GCSE & IGCSE Results

- In terms of examination success, Whitgift had a record-breaking year.
- At GCSE, 87% of all grades were at A or A*, exceeding our previous best performance achieved last year. An outstanding 57% of grades achieved were at A*.
- 24 pupils in the Upper Fifth Form achieved a clean sweep of A* grades. In total, 85 boys achieved all A*/A grades in their GCSE examinations.
- In the Upper Sixth, the A*-B rate for A Level was 91% with 33% of all grades being at A*, breaking the previous record. The A*-B rate for A Level and the IB (International Baccalaureate) Diploma combined was 92.6%.
- At A Level, a total of 64 pupils achieved all A*/A grades.
- The average total points score in the IB diploma was just over 38, up on last year, with over a third of candidates gaining 40 or more points out of the maximum of 45. 80% of individual subject grades were at 6 or 7.
- There was exceptional success in gaining places at top universities, including 24 at Oxford and Cambridge. In all, 80% of boys secured admission to their first choice university, mostly at Russell Group universities. A growing number of pupils are looking to study outside the UK, including three successful applicants to American universities.
- Results in the Extended Project Qualification were excellent. Research topics ranged widely from 'Using two case studies, to what extent is WikiLeaks justified?' to 'What was the role of asteroids and comets in the development of life on Earth?'
- 49 pupils in the Upper Fifth Form completed the challenging Additional Mathematics qualification, with 34 obtaining the top grade.

BTEC National Diploma 2015

Eight boys gained the Level 3 Extended Diploma in Sport & Exercise Science, five at D*D*D and the remainder with D*DD, DDD and DDM. Some of these boys are taking up places at University, including at Durham, Exeter and Loughborough, while two boys have been signed up on professional sporting contracts.

Examination Success

- Whitgift's joint top-scorers in the International Baccalaureate, Matthew Choy and Koyo Harada, on 44 points, are bound for Cambridge to study Medicine and Natural Sciences respectively.
- Stefan Amokwandoh has been awarded a full scholarship to study at Princeton in the USA.
- Henry Choong achieved grade 1 in both the STEP II and STEP III papers (Sixth Term Entrance Papers) to take up his place at St John's College, Cambridge to read Mathematics.
- In GCSE History, 77 boys gained 100 UMS (full marks) on one or more units.
- In Mathematics modules over the two years, Upper Sixth Form boys were awarded 100 UMS (full marks) in 152 papers.

STEM Subjects: Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics

- In the Senior Mathematics Challenge, Whitgift pupils achieved 28 gold, 24 silver and 47 bronze awards. Six pupils qualified for the British Mathematical Olympiad and 13 pupils qualified for the Senior Kangaroo Challenge. Two boys went on to Round 2 of the BMO.
- In the Intermediate Mathematics Challenge, Whitgift pupils achieved 19 gold, 56 silver and 59 bronze awards. Four pupils qualified for the Intermediate Mathematical Olympiad. Eight pupils qualified for other further rounds.
- In the Junior Mathematics Challenge, Whitgift pupils achieved 25 gold, 41 silver and 46 bronze awards. Three pupils qualified for the Junior Mathematical Olympiad.
- In the RSC Chemistry Olympiad, Whitgift Sixth Formers achieved six gold, six silver and six bronze awards.
- In the Cambridge Chemistry Challenge, Whitgift Sixth Formers achieved three gold, five silver and six copper awards.
- In the Lower Fifth Form Biology Challenge, Whitgift boys achieved four gold, 17 silver and 27 bronze awards. In the Upper Sixth Form Biology Olympiad, there were three silver and four bronze awards.
- In the Intermediate Physics Challenge, Whitgift boys achieved one gold, two silver and nine bronze awards. In the Senior Physics Challenge, there were two gold, four silver and 12 bronze awards.
- Three Lower Sixth Form Physics students attended the CERN summer school, being awarded places through the CERN essay competition.
- The National Arkwright Scholarship Scheme aims to inspire and encourage the most talented young people towards a career in Engineering. Currently, five Sixth Form students have been awarded a scholarship for 2015-2017 with a further student gaining a commendation.
