

- > Cricket CAG/County Performance/District
- > Football Professional Academy/District
- > Hockey Standout player in School/Club
- > Rugby Standout player in School/Club
- > Swimming/Athletics County standard times/distances
- > Tennis/Badminton/Squash/Table Tennis County standard
- > Fencing/Modern Pentathlon National standard
- > Basketball/Water polo Standout club player
- > Golf below 18 official handicap

How to Apply

- > Complete this application form and upload it as part of the main application. You will be prompted when to do this on the main application form
- > The Form should include:
 - a list of teams your son has represented
 - a list of any representational honours
 - any other relevant information, including times and distances
- > Sporting reference from school PE/Games Teacher OR Head of Sport*
- > Sporting Testimonials from relevant sports coaches*
- > Certificates are **not** required
- * These documents should be saved together as one file and uploaded when completing the main application form in the Scholarship testimonial upload area. Accepted file formats are PDF, .doc, jpeg and jpg.
